
EMBROIDERY STITCHES



BACKSTITCH

- 1. Begin by coming up at point A. This will be approximately 1/8" from the start of the stitching line.
- 2. Pull the floss to the front of the fabric.
- 3. Insert the needle at point B which is at the beginning of the stitch line.
- 4. Come up at point C which is 1/8" from point A.
- 5. Bring the floss all the way through to the front of the fabric.
- 6. Go back down at point A and then up at point C. Repeat the stitch






SATIN STITCH

- 1. Bring your needle up at 1 and then down at 2
- 2. Start your next stitch at 3 bringing it up and then back down at 4.
- 3. Continue filling in the area placing the stitches closely together.

RUNNING STITCH

- 1. Start by bringing the floss up at 1 and down at 2.
- 2. Continue by bringing up at 3 and down at 4.
- 3. You will be working from right to left








FRENCH KNOTS

- 1. Bring needle up at 1 as shown in diagram 1.
- 2. Hold the floss tight with the other hand and wrap in around the end of the needle two times.
- 3. Pull the floss gently so that the wrapped floss tighten.
- 4. Insert the needle next to 1 as shown in diagram 2.
- 5. Pull the floss through the back until a knot is made.

LAZY DAISY

- 1. Bring the needle up at point A and go back down close to point A to form a loop on the front side
- 2. Bring the needle up at point B and pull the floss to shape a loop into the desired shape.
- 3. Secure the loop made with a small stitch
